

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST FOR SAFEGUARDS (ENVIRONMENTAL & SOCIAL) POSITIONS

Federated States of Micronesia, World Bank Financed Projects

The Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) has received financing from the World Bank (WB) for the implementation of a number of projects in the following sectors: Fisheries, ICT, Energy, Finance and Maritime. The FSM government intends to apply part of the grant proceeds to support the safeguard aspects of the projects to ensure compliance with the FSM and State Government and World Bank's policies and systems.

Therefore the FSM National Government is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) from motivated, qualified and experienced FSM Safeguard Specialist (Environment and Social) to work with the CIU International Safeguard Advisor (ISA) and individual project managers to strengthen and support the successful delivery of a range of environmental and social safeguard services within the WB FSM portfolio. The FSM government seeking to appoint up to two positions based on the experience of the applicants associated with environmental and social safeguard requirements.

The following expertise and level of experience is required:

- Graduate diploma or degree (preferred) in environmental and/or social science, environmental engineering, planning or similar relevant discipline;
- At least 5 years relevant project experience (government, private or NGO) associated with environmental and/or social management and/or assessment of impacts from infrastructure projects.
- Demonstrable experience with relevant projects (government, private or NGO) associated with FSM National and/or State safeguard laws, policies and regulations and/or equivalent development partner activities.
- Demonstrated ability in effective project management, including: expertise in work planning; an ability to manage their own time effectively, an ability to work in a team; effective at providing advice and outputs on time and to agreed quality; and be able to communicate effectively and build relationships with a range of stakeholders;
- Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of FSM national and state policies, laws and regulations pertaining to environmental and social management and protection, infrastructure development and management; and
- Proficient speaking and writing professionally in English.^[1]_{SEP}
